

## **Procedure for a Resident of Pearlinton applying for a Salvation Army Grant**

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For a resident of Pearlinton to apply for a rebuilding grant from the Salvation Army, the following protocol must be observed, exactly:

- 1) resident must have a "sponsoring" Non-Profit Organization (501c3) make the application on your behalf;
- 2) the Sponsor must be willing to commit to providing the labor required to commence the project and to fully complete the work committed under the Grant;
- 3) the Resident must provide the following:
  - pictures of the residence following Hurricane Katrina;
  - pictures of any progress made toward rebuilding since Katrina;
  - a Materials List, with estimates of costs, from Home Depot or Lowes;
  - this Materials List must not exceed, prior to taxes, Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00);
  - a Summary Letter explaining what happened to the residence during the storm;
  - what, if any, FEMA or insurance money was received by the Resident
  - an explanation of how that money was spent, or disbursed;
  - a list of any other help you have received - financial, labor or materials included;
  - name of the Sponsoring Organization, including contact name(s), address(es), phone number(s) and email address(es), if applicable.

Please be aware that each of the non-profit organizations working in Pearlinton are aware of the need to be a Sponsor for many Residents wishing to rebuild their home.

However, volunteer laborers - many of which need to be skilled in certain aspects of home building - are not easy to come by.

Please rest assured that each organization is doing its utmost to do what it can to get Pearlinton back on its feet.
